Support at Home Program

If you are funded under the Support at Home Program, Cobram Regional Care can provide you with all the support that you need to manage your care needs.

To access funding, you will be required to undergo a comprehensive assessment through My Aged Care to determine the help that you need and the level of services that may be best for you. If your funding is managed by another organisation you can request to have your Support at Home funding transferred to Cobram Regional Care. Cobram Regional Care do not charge set up fees.

The Australian Government Contribution

The Australian Government contributes a different amount for each level. **The table below outlines the funding amounts for each of the 8 ongoing service classifications.** These funding amounts include funding for care management. Funding amounts are indicative and are subject to indexation revisions.

The costs will be deducted from your overall Support at Home funding budget. Prices for Common Services are hourly rates with a minimum service charge for each of 30 minutes between 7.30am and 5pm on weekdays and one (1) hour all other times.

Contribution Arrangements

Under the Support at Home program, clients will only pay contributions on the services they receive. Any costs for delivery of care management services are included for care management. Clients will not make a co-contribution towards the cost of their clinical care, which includes care management.

Clients may be assessed by Government as needing to make a co-contribution for 'independence' or 'everyday living' services. For example, if a person receives two hours of personal care, they will pay a contribution per hour received. If they receive 5 meals, they will pay a contribution for each meal.

Actual contribution rates are determined by Services Australia through an assessment of the person's income and assets. For full and part pensioners this will be based on information already provided for their pension assessment.
